



THE BOWEN FORUM

Requirements for application to join the CNHC Bowen Technique Register and at annual renewal.

Applying practitioner must:

1. Have met the agreed standards of proficiency for the Bowen Technique as stated in the Core Curriculum on the Bowen Forum website www.bowenforum.org.uk

NB. If unable to meet Core Curriculum, practitioner can upgrade to standards of proficiency, using the framework as agreed by the Bowen Forum, Profession Specific Board and Professional Associations, in order to gain entry to the register.

2. Provide evidence of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) to the equivalent of two days per year since qualification. See the accompanying Bowen CPD document for details of criteria.

NB. If unable to meet this requirement, individual assessment and recommendations by the Bowen Forum, Profession Specific Board and Professional Associations are available in order to gain entry to the register.

3. Have an Anatomy & Physiology certificate to minimum standard of ITEC level 3, City & Guilds schedule 2a, NVQ3, N.F.W. VTCT or other professional training.

NB. If not of sufficient level practitioner can provide details in order for individual assessment and, if appropriate, recommendations by CNHC Profession Specific Board.

4. Have a current First Aid certificate valid for at least one year from date of registration with CNHC - minimum standard of one day Appointed Person First Aid with a Health & Safety Executive-approved course provider.

5. Have current Professional Indemnity insurance for a minimum of £2million (recommended £5million) Public Liability cover.

6. Have declared that they are Fit to Practice as described by CNHC. It is the practitioner's responsibility to inform the CNHC within two months if their personal circumstances change in this respect.

7. Have provided an independent reference of their good character as described in the Standards for Entry to the CNHC Register.

8. Have declared they do not have a criminal record and have no pending criminal investigation.

NB. If unable to make this declaration and practitioner wishes to continue with application practitioner can provide details in order for individual assessment and, if appropriate, recommendations by CNHC Profession Specific Board.

9. Have declared that they have not been and are not presently the subject of any disciplinary or civil proceedings against them in relation to their practice.

NB. If either of these instances do apply and practitioner wishes to continue with application practitioner can provide details in order for individual assessment and, if appropriate, recommendations by CNHC Profession Specific Board.

10. Have agreed to abide by the CNHC and Bowen Forum Codes of Conduct, Performance and Ethics.
